*Policy statement - J+J Automation UK Ltd*

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive 2002/96/EC stipulates that producers of electrical and electronic equipment are responsible for its reuse, recycling or disposal at the end of its useful life.

Under the above EC Directive, we are classified as an Equipment Producer.

J+J Automation UK Ltd is committed to respect the WEEE directive.

We will discharge our responsibilities under this directive from the 1st July 2007 (the start of the first compliance period) as a member of a WEEE Compliance Scheme, and have joined the B2B compliance scheme operated by DHL.

We have registered as a producer under this scheme and will provide all relevant information in order that DHL can discharge their obligations in respect of WEEE.

We are registered as a 'Producer' of WEEE with the Environment Agency, Registration number WEE/JC00562TQ.

Where applicable, our products carry the crossed out wheelee bin logo.

Our products are identified by our logo:



At the end of the useful life of our products, customers can return products marked with this logo to us and we will arrange the recycling or disposal at no further cost to the customer. From 1st July 2007, a small Environmental Charge per WEEE item will be levied on all invoices.
